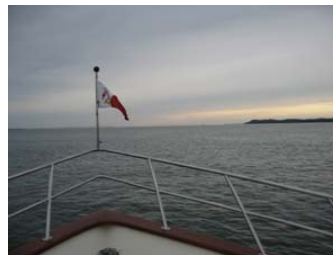

## Leg 1: Gold Coast to Urangan Boat Harbour, Harvey Bay

With a 100% turn out of Eagle owners, the fleet of 1 set out from the Gold Coast for an overnight leg to Widebay Bar and Garry's Anchorage. The 8 - 10 knot SE forecast accompanied by a heavy 2.7 - 3M swell from the SE (thanks to low of New Zealand) saw us arriving at dawn to cross Wide Bay Bar 2 hours before high and travel up the Great Sand Straights to Garry's Anchorage.

The Northstar GPS & Radar certainly helps confirm your location along the preset route steered by the autopilot from the Seaway to the Wide Bay Bar. The AIS system (Automatic Identification System) also came in to its own with up to a dozen tankers, cargo ships and cruise liners standing off Point Cartwright all entering or leaving Brisbane being able to confirm their size, speed, direction, closest point and time of approach on the AIS at night was fantastic.



Sandy Straights

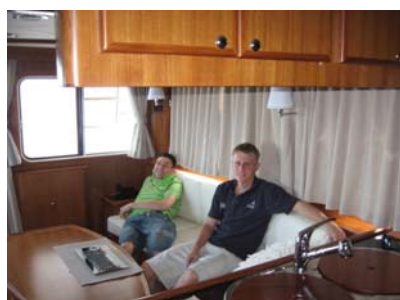


Garry's Anchorage
